Visions of Beauty

The third instalment of *Singapore Tatler's* Wellness Talk provided an enriching afternoon that zoomed in on the art, science and mathematics of aesthetic perfection

With the aim of bringing men and women closer to their beauty ideals, Singapore Tatler hosted its third Wellness Talk, which saw over 80 women gain insights from two plastic surgeons.

cosmetology plastic surgeon at his namesake plastic surgery practice, talked about "facial rejuvenation the right way". Addressing the benefits of well-known procedures such as filler and chemical peels, Correa also noted on the advantages of a facelift compared to newer, quick-fixes such as a thread lift. "A facelift 10 years ago still looks and feels like a lifetime," he says.

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In addition to topics such as popular beauty trends and procedures developed and favoured by Korean and Japanese markets, Tan also talked about the mathematics behind beauty, and with the aid of presentation slides, compared calculated versions of the "perfect face" of women from different parts of the world against Leonardo da Vinci's golden ratio of 1:1.618.
