It runs a pro bono medical clinic to provide free services to those in need – for example they remove tattoos for those who cannot afford expensive laser treatment. Says Chai Ling. "I believe in karma, so if I help others now, in the future when I need help, hopefully, someone will extend a helping hand to me too."
